

Nappy Changing Policy

Children will be included at Playschool regardless of whether or not they are toilet trained.

Playschool will provide appropriate nappy changing facilities.

Parents will be asked to provide nappies, baby wipes and nappy sacks for their child but supplies will be kept at Playschool if these are forgotten.

Changing mats will be cleaned with disinfectant spray after each use.

Disposable gloves will be used when changing nappies. Disposable aprons are available if needed.

Soiled nappies and wipes will be double wrapped in bags and at the end of the Playschool session given to the child's parent for disposal at home.

A record will be kept showing which members of staff have changed nappies during a Playschool session.

Playschool staff will work with parents to adopt a supportive and consistent approach when children are being toilet trained.

Door to be kept open when a child's nappy is changed as in line with our Safeguarding Policy.
